

MEDIA RELEASE: Sculpture Sounds at Heide
For immediate release

A free new children’s program at Heide Museum of Modern Art encourages families to interact with outdoor art through music and play.



A musical journey through Heide’s sculpture park, ‘Sculpture Sounds’ has been created by artists from the musical collective *Between Footsteps*. It encompasses six percussive tracks that have been inspired by sculptures in the Connie Kimberley Sculpture Park at Heide. The combination of the sights and sounds inspires children’s imaginations and allows them to immerse themselves in outdoor art and music in a brand new way.

The rhythms, tones, and melodies of the music evoke patterns, feelings, and imaginative landscapes that encourage children to perceive their environments differently. The music features electric guitar, percussion and drums and it also incorporates sounds of the sculptures and the natural parkland.

How it works:

1. Download the Sculpture Sounds musical tracks from the Heide website (www.heide.com.au/sculpture-sounds) to a smart phone or device.
2. Follow the map in the activity sheet (available online or at the Heide information desk) to find and “listen” to the sculptures, and complete each activity.
